

IMPORT OF REMOVALS

ARGENTINEAN CITIZEN FOREIGNER WITH PERMANENT RESIDENCY

DOCUMENTATION

1. Original passport: upon arriving at Ezeiza airport, the passport must be:
 - Stamped by Migration with the date of entry. If the passport is not stamped, please download the “Constancia de Ingreso” from <https://www.migraciones.gov.ar/transitos>

Argentineans with multiple citizenship: must enter with Argentine passport.

2. Fully certified and legalized passport copies, including the blank pages (if it has been issued for less than 2 years, a fully certified and legalized copy of the previous passport will also be required).
3. Visa or another document at country of origin.
4. Residence Certificate issued by the Argentine Consulate at country of origin showing that you have lived more than 2 years abroad. It must be legalized by the same Consulate. **Please bear in mind that this certificate has 6 months of validity from its issuance.**
5. Migration Certificate of the last 3 years issued by the Dirección Nacional de Migraciones (Argentina). **After your arrival in Argentina**, you can obtain it through Migration’s web page: <http://www.migraciones.gov.ar/certificaciones/index.htm>, or our company can obtain it on your behalf with an additional cost.
6. DNI copy, front and back.
7. CUIL copy.
8. Certificate of address in Argentina issued by the police, Registro Civil or notary (only required for shipments by sea and road).
9. Certified and legalized signature on a form that we provide.

Certifications and legalizations (points 2 and 9): by a public notary (in Argentina) and the Colegio de Escribanos, being able to do it at our office from 11:30am to 4:30pm by appointment.

ARTWORKS

To comply with the Law of International Circulation of Artworks (24.633), in case of owning artworks such as paintings, sculptures, drawings, engravings, collages, ceramics or textile art, a clear photo of each piece separately and the following information will be required: type of object, materials used, measurements in centimeters, title, year of creation or production and author (also applicable for artworks of your own authorship, any member of the family or friend). **A chart is included on page 3 of this PDF for your reference.** This will be used to process the corresponding import permit at the Ministry of Culture.

The described in the previous paragraph must be done prior to the packing service at origin in order to avoid delays.

REMARKS

- a. A move will be allowed every 3 years after having lived abroad for more than 1 year, as long as the occasional trips to Argentina during that year do not exceed the 60 days.
- b. A move will be allowed every 7 years after having lived abroad for more than 2 years, which must be proved with the Certificate of Residence issued by the Argentine Consulate at the country of origin. In this case, the 60 days informed in point a. are not computed.
- c. The personal effects must arrive up to 6 months after the consignee’s arrival in Argentina.
- d. The shipment cannot arrive at Buenos Aires port/airport prior to the consignee’s arrival in Argentina.
- e. If for any reason the consignee must travel abroad, the clearance process will be on hold until he/she returns to Argentina.
- f. The presence of the consignee is required during the customs inspection at port.

Personal Data: All documentation containing personal information will be treated confidentially, not distributed except for the purposes for which it is requested. Exempting legitimate requests from law enforcement authorities.

IMPORT OF REMOVALS

FOREIGNER WITH PRECARIA OR TEMPORARY VISA

DOCUMENTATION

1. Original passport: upon arriving at Ezeiza airport, the passport must be:
 - Stamped by Migration with the date of entry. If the passport is not stamped, please download the “Constancia de Ingreso” from <https://www.migraciones.gov.ar/transitos>
2. Fully certified and legalized passport copies, including the blank pages (if it has been issued for less than 1 year, a fully certified and legalized copy of the previous passport will also be required).
3. Visa or another document at country of origin (if applicable).
4. Precaria or Temporary visa in Argentina.
5. DNI copy, front and back (Argentine ID card, only if available).
6. CUIL copy (labor ID in Argentina).
7. Migration Certificate of the last 3 years issued by the Dirección Nacional de Migraciones (Argentina). **After your arrival in Argentina**, you can obtain it through Migration’s web page: <http://www.migraciones.gov.ar/certificaciones/index.htm>, or our company can obtain it on your behalf with an additional cost.
8. Letter from the employer in Argentina (model to be provided by our company / only required for shipments by sea and road).
9. Certificate of address in Argentina issued by the police, Registro Civil or notary (only required for shipments by sea and road).
10. Certified and legalized signature on a form that we provide.
11. Customs Guarantee for the temporary admission of your shipment. (*)

Certifications and legalizations (points 2 and 10): by a public notary (in Argentina) and the Colegio de Escribanos, being able to do it at our office from 11:30am to 4:30pm by appointment.

ARTWORKS

To comply with the Law of International Circulation of Artworks (24.633), in case of owning artworks such as paintings, sculptures, drawings, engravings, collages, ceramics or textile art, a clear photo of each piece separately and the following information will be required: type of object, materials used, measurements in centimeters, title, year of creation or production and author (also applicable for artworks of your own authorship, any member of the family or friend). **A chart is included on page 3 of this PDF for your reference.** This will be used to process the corresponding import permit at the Ministry of Culture.

The described in the previous paragraph must be done prior to the packing service at origin in order to avoid delays.

REMARKS

- a. (*) The customs guarantee is backed up with a policy issued by an Argentine insurance company. Once affected by the Customs, the shipment is released under temporary admission, which must be renewed periodically for as long as the foreign citizen stays in Argentina, renewing the visa until obtained the permanent residency or exported the same volume / weight imported.
- b. The personal effects must arrive up to 6 months after the consignee’s arrival in Argentina.
- c. The shipment cannot arrive at Buenos Aires port/airport prior to the consignee’s arrival in Argentina.
- g. If for any reason the consignee must travel abroad, the clearance process will be on hold until he/she returns to Argentina.
- d. The presence of the consignee is required during the customs inspection at port.
